Call for Abstracts

The Rocky Mountain/ACP Internal Medicine Conference is committed to providing high quality education, research and clinical practice support to academic and community-based General Internists. The Rocky Mountain/ACP Internal Medicine Conference supports and encourages resident and faculty research participation. Abstract submissions are being accepted for the 2017 meeting, for case presentations and research projects. Guidelines are as follows:

General guidelines for submission:

- Deadline for submission is September 15, 2017. Submit all required documents as Microsoft Word files to rmresearch@ucalgary.ca
- Abstracts should be less than 300 words.
- Include an identifying title, the names and affiliations of contributing authors, any funding support received, and 3-5 key words.
- All submissions must be signed by the supervising faculty overseeing the care of the patient or project.
- Complete the Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement
- Provide 1 or 2 learning objectives in the form of, "At the end of this presentation, attendees will be able to..."

Case presentations:

- The body must contain no data that would allow identification of the patient
- A letter of release of information signed by the patient must be provided.

Research projects:

- Structure abstracts with background, methods, results and conclusion sections.

Abstracts will be reviewed by the Annual Meeting Committee with notification regarding selection sent out by October 15th, 2017. Selected abstracts will be invited for a poster presentation, and in the resident category only, two abstracts will be selected for a 15-minute oral presentation rather than a poster. The best case report and best research project in the

resident category (from both oral and poster presentations) will receive awards following the graded presentations on November 17, 2017.

Finally, all abstracts accepted at the Rocky Mountain Conference will be published in the Canadian Journal of General Internal Medicine.
